

Emergency shelters provide temporary shelter beds, generally up to 30-90 days, depending on the program and bed availability.

WHAT TO EXPECT:


Shared housing with other young adults (Ages 16-24)

Assessment of health and mental health care needs

What is Emergency Housing?

Connection to longer term housing options

Case by case services, housing options and plans



Connection to public benefits (i.e., SSI, SSDI, CalWORKs, food stamps and General Relief)



Support reconnecting with families, if desired
