What is Long-Term Housing?



APARTMENT IN A BUILDING WITH ON-SITE SERVICES OR AN APARTMENT IN THE COMMUNITY

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Individualized support services

Connection to mental health services or substance use treatment supports

Case by case services, housing options and plans

Connection to public benefits

(i.e., SSI, SSDI, CalWORKs, food stamps and General Relief)

Support Services

(i.e., case management, employment, education, or life skills) on-site or through community linkages



RENTAL SUBSIDY ASSISTANCE

(i.e., Section 8 vouchers: eligibility is partially based on income and youth pay 30% of their income to the landlord.)
