

What is Short-Term Housing?

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Short-term housing consists of temporary or transitional housing and support services, generally up to 24 months.

Up to 2 years of housing with support services

Housing with a shared room or shared housing with separate rooms at a single site or scattered site locations

Assessment of health and mental health care needs

Case management services
